For the month of July Grocey Outlet will be hosting their Independence From Hunger event benefitting the Food Closet. Last year they raised \$13,000 and this year they have a goal of \$15,000. Local businesses have been given the opportunity to partner with the store and sponsor a match day. Last year Future Honda matched \$1000 and hopes to reach that amount this year as well. All donations raised go to stocking our homeless pantry as well as buying gift cards that are given out year-round including at our annual Thanksgiving distribution.
